"The Rascals Have Been Expecting Us" at Renfrew Museum and Park

All items should be of good quality and standards should be of utmost authenticity.

Headwear:

-Civilian wide-brimmed, as pictured & worn by the original cast preferred

-Type 1 & 2 Forage Caps preferred

-IN LIMITED NUMBERS: Undressed M1858 Hardee. Please contact myself privately before bringing this.

**NOTE: Although the units most appealing feature appears on headgear (the Bucktail,) not all wore them. There should be a healthy mix of both headgear with, and without, Bucktails. Any civilian headgear should be without hat brass (occasional blue disc corps badge wool acceptable—NO metal or "gambling chip" corps badges,) and Forage Caps should sport a "149" and/or "C"—NO infantry insignias (see "Original Cast" album for details on why!)

Jackets:

-Frock Coat Preferred! If you have it, please wear it.

-Fatigue Blouse (Sack Coat,) or private purchase, accepted (Schuylkill Arsenal prefferred)

**NOTE: NCOs (as chosen by event staff) should wear appropriate pantstripe & subdued Chevrons of black/navy velvet, as pictured by the original cast.

Shirts & Drawers:

-Standard Issue Preferred

-Civilian Drawers/Homespun shirts of quality accepted

Trousers:

-Federal Trousers, Schuylkill Arsenal contract preferred

-Federal Trousers of other contracts accepted

Footwear:

-Jefferson "bootees" (brogans) preferred

-Infantry-styled private purchase boots, in limited numbers. No camp shoes.

Leathers:

-Standard issue US belt w/ cap pouch & 2-rivet bayonet preferred

-Cartridge box w/ sling & breastplate preferred

-Philadelphia '62 bullseye canteens w/ cloth strap preferred, other styles of federal canteens accepted

-Standard issue black tarred haversack

Tentage:

-US issued blanket preferred

-homespun coverlets/blankets of quality accepted

-US issue gum blankets preferred

-Type 2 Shelter Half, no canvas or other styles of Shelter Halves accepted

-Blanket Roll

-Standard issue knapsack

Arms:

-1853 Enfields preferred

-1861 & 63 Springfields accepted in limited numbers

-All other styles of 3-band rifles accepted

**NOTE: no Sharps rifles, 2-bander zouave rifles, Lorenzes
